

## SAFFY'S CASE STUDY

Saffy - a fit and active 13yr old Irish Draught X Thoroughbred mare who until March 2006 had her hoof walls stapled.

This was viewed as the only way Saffy could continue to function with her very poor feet. Her owners at that time had been told to expect her to remain this way all her working life.

Saffy's owners were not happy with this prognosis so looked for an alternative to her present treatment. Fortunately for Saffy in March 2006 they employed the skills of Applied Equine Podiatrist Trevor Jones who immediately removed the staples from her hooves, applied the High Performance Trim and gave her owners the necessary recommendation concerning environment, exercise etc.

As you can see from the photographs below, Saffy's improvement over the first 6 months of her new hoof care programme showed great results.
